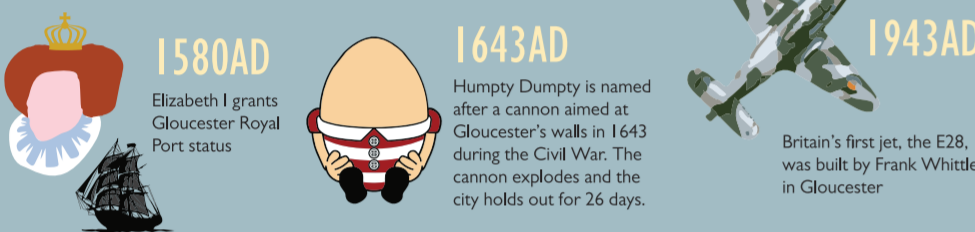


A SHORT HISTORY OF GLOUCESTER

- 1 Beatrix Potter House of the Tailor of Gloucester**
Beatrix Potter created one of her most loved characters here (The Tailor of Gloucester). This charming shop and museum, housed the same building that inspired the very story and is used in the illustrations, is open to the public every day where you will be served by enthusiastic and knowledgeable volunteers.
- 2 Discover De Crypt**
Historic church in the heart of the city, go on self-guided tour using the app. Discover the amazing stories of Joan Cooke, founder of the Crypt School, Robert Raikes and others. The church is also venue for concerts and talks.
- 3 Discover Paddling**
Stand-up paddleboarding and kayaking in the fabulous surroundings of Gloucester Docks.

- 4 The Folk of Gloucester**
An exquisite Tudor timber-framed building that was once the Folk Museum. It is now a community space for exhibitions, events & activities. Objects from the City collection bring to life stories of the people of the City of Gloucester from the Tudor period to the present day.
- 5 Gloucester Cathedral**
One of the finest medieval buildings in the country and the burial place of royalty. The extraordinary fan-faulted medieval cloisters (often featured in film and TV) and Great East Window are national treasures.
- 6 Gloucester Guildhall**
Entertainment venue hosting live music, comedy, theatre, film, exhibitions and talks.
- 7 Gloucester City A.F.C**
Gloucester City Association Football Club is an English association football club based in Hempsted, Gloucester.
- 8 Gloucester Rugby**
The Cherry and Whites play at Kingsholm where they compete in the Premiership and European Challenge Cup. The club was also proud to be a host stadium for the Rugby World Cup 2015. Gloucester is a true rugby city, where people proudly walk the streets wearing the famous Cherry and White hoops.
- 9 GL1 Leisure Centre**
At GL1, we have something for every member of the family. Don't be fooled into thinking that we're just a gym and a swimming pool – with an on-site spa and café, there really is something to keep everyone entertained.
- 10 Gloucester Ski & Snowboard Centre GL4 6EA**
One of the longest outdoor artificial ski slopes in the UK for skiing and snowboarding fun. There are activities for the whole family from various tuition courses, recreational skiing or boarding or even tubing in inflatable rings.

- 12 Jet Age Museum GL2 9QL**
Weekends only. The Jet Age Museum is home to a unique collection of historic aircraft and artefacts charting the history of Gloucestershire's rich aviation heritage.
- 13 Llanthony Secunda Priory**
A once large and important Augustinian Priory which was founded outside the city walls in 1136. It is a scheduled monument with listed buildings that has played an important part in Gloucester's history for over 900 years. Newly restored and now an exciting venue for events.
- 14 St Michaels Tower**
15th century tower situated in the centre of Gloucester and headquarters now of the Gloucester Civic Trust. Inside you will find exhibition on History of St Michael the Archangel church including a historical timeline dating back to before 1066.
- 15 Museum of Gloucester**
The Museum of Gloucester features ground floor exhibitions and exhibits that promise a much more interactive experience. Highlights include a Roman kitchen playhouse and medieval street. Part of the original Roman wall can also be viewed within the museum.
- 16 National Waterways Museum**
Take a 'Journey Through Britain' in the award winning National Waterways Museum Gloucester, which tells the

A real-life room escape game which requires players to work together to solve hidden puzzles to escape a locked themed room, before the 1-hour timer runs out.

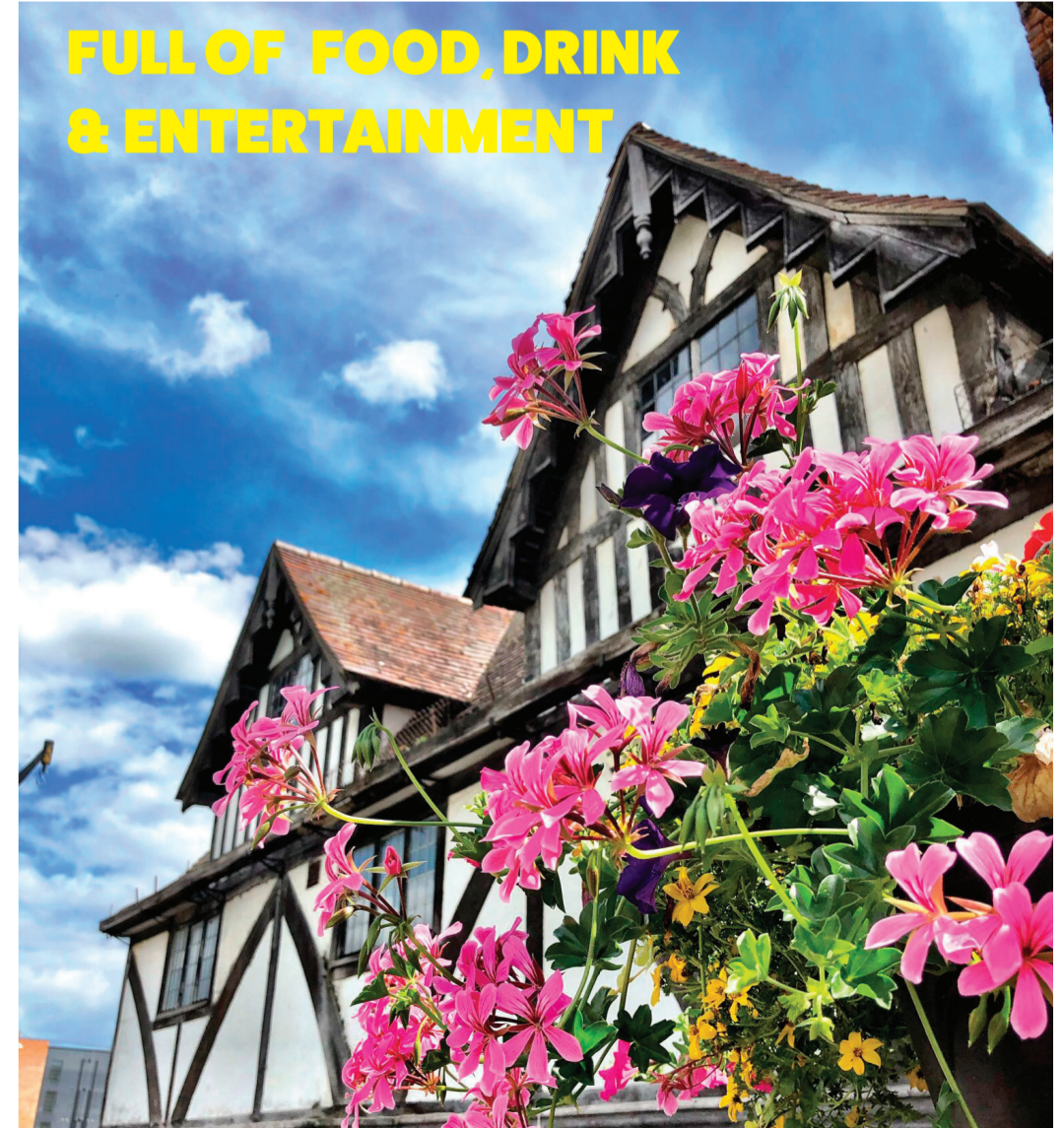

Gloucester's stunning architecture is quickly becoming a firm favourite with movie and TV producers in Hollywood and the UK. Walk in the footsteps of the stars of stage and screen with our guide here.

- Alice Through The Looking Glass (2016)**
From Disney Studios, the sequel to Tim Burton's Alice in Wonderland hit the big screen in 2016. The production took over Gloucester Docks for a week with Alice herself (Mia Wasikowska) taking part in the maritime scene. The producers chose Gloucester Docks for the film after seeing images of the Gloucester Tall Ships Festival.
- Sherlock (2015)**
Filming took place in January 2015 for an episode of the BBC's Sherlock, featuring Benedict Cumberbatch, Martin Freeman, Mark Gatiss and Amanda Abbington
- Wolf Hall (2015)**
Mark Rylance stars as Thomas Cromwell opposite Damien Lewis as King Henry VIII in a lavish adaptation of Hilary Mantel's Booker Prize-winning novel, Wolf Hall. Part of the filming took place at Gloucester Cathedral during the summer of 2014.
- The Hollow Crown (2012 and 2015)**
Originally part of the London 2012 Cultural Olympiad, the BBC's adaptations of William Shakespeare's Henry IV Parts 1 and 2 and Henry V - starring Jeremy Irons and Tom Hiddleston, featured Gloucester Cathedral doubling up as the Royal Palace of Westminster. The second part of the series starred Benedict Cumberbatch and was also filmed in Gloucester Cathedral.
- Amazing Grace (2006)**
The story of William Wilberforce and the Abolitionists movement to end the transatlantic slave trade. Starring Iwan Rheon, Albert Finney, Michael Gambon and Benedict Cumberbatch.
- Peter Rabbit 2 (2020)**
James Corden is the voice of Peter again in the upcoming sequel. The trailer features shots of The House of the Tailor of Gloucester, Gloucester Docks, the Cathedral and even a spot of cheese rolling!
- Dr Who (2020, 2008)**
The Gloucester Cathedral grounds have been used as a location for Doctor Who on a couple of occasions. Most recently, Jodie Whittaker faced off against the Judoon, whilst David Tennant starred in 2008's Christmas special.
- Mary Queen of Scots (2019)**
Margot Robbie's Elizabeth I held court in a number of seamlessly blended locations including the Cathedral cloisters. The lavish production also starred Saoirse Ronan, Guy Pearce and David Tennant.
